

Level 2 Certificate in Safeguarding, Prevent and British Values

This course in Safeguarding, Prevent & British Values leads to a fully recognised RQF qualification. Fully accredited by Training Qualifications (TQUK). The purpose of this qualification is to develop your understanding of the Prevent duty, British values, safeguarding and online safety.

You will develop knowledge, understanding and skills to enable you to uphold British values in your current or future role. This includes developing an understanding of the effects of extremism, radicalisation and terrorism. The aims are to promote equality, diversity and social inclusion in the workplace to support the Governments agenda on tackling radicalisation and extremism.

The qualification also develops your knowledge and understanding of safeguarding and online safety. The knowledge and skills developed are appropriate to a wide range of job roles and are relevant to organisations in meeting their statutory requirements under the Prevent Duty. The qualification is appropriate to a wide range of learners especially those on apprenticeship programmes or other training to prepare for work or as part of induction to a job role. It can also be used as part of citizenship programmes for individuals coming to live in the UK.
